- General ophthalmology

- Glaucoma treatment and monitoring
- Medical retina (excluding diabetic retinopathy)
- YAG laser capsulotomy
- YAG laser peripheral iridotomy
- YAG laser SLT
- Oculoplastic and lacrimal surgeries, including:
 - Excision of eyelid lesion
 - Biopsy of eyelid lesion
 - Chalazion (subject to INNf approval)
 - Irrigation of nasolacrimal duct
 - 3-snip punctoplasty
 - Punctal plugs
 - Blepharoplasty (subject to INNf approval)
 - Entropion
 - Ectropion
 - Ptosis

- Trabeculectomy surgery
- Vitreoretinal surgery
